## BY-LAW 2 ANNEX G DIRECTOR OF HISTORY AND HERITAGE TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 1. The Director of History and Heritage is selected by the Executive Committee and is a voting member of the CMPA Executive Committee. The of Director History and Heritage is responsible for carrying out the following roles and responsibilities:
  - Advising the CMPA on what Military Police Branch history and heritage should be preserved;
  - Advising on the state of Branch efforts to collect and preserve the history and heritage of the Branch be it held by MP units/organizations or by other organizations (e.g. military museums);
  - Advising on dates of anniversaries and events for official ceremonies;
  - Coordinating CMPA efforts to mark major Branch anniversaries;
  - Preparing History and Heritage articles for the CMPA webpage;
  - Liaising with the Military Police Branch, as a whole, and the Canadian Forces Military Police Academy, in particular, regarding their efforts to collect and preserve history and heritage in the Branch's heritage collection;
  - Liaising with the appropriate museum authorities to further preservation efforts;
  - Acting as the CMPA contact point for submission of MP-related artifacts from the field; and
  - Advising the CMPA Executive Committee on support requirements for the Branch's heritage collection.
- 2. The Director of History and Heritage may enlist the help of other CMPA members in support of these goals.
