DIRECTOR HISTORY AND HERITAGE

TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. The Director History and Heritage is elected by the membership and is a voting member of the CMPA Executive Committee. The Director History and Heritage is responsible to the President for the following:

- Advising the CMPA on what Military Police Branch history and heritage should be preserved;
- Advising on the state of CMPA efforts to collect and preserve the history and heritage;
- Advising on dates of anniversaries and events for official ceremonies;
- Coordinating CMPA efforts to mark major Branch anniversaries;
- Prepare History and Heritage articles for the CMPA Web page;
- Liaising with the Military Police Branch as a whole, and the Canadian Forces Military Police Academy in particular, regarding their efforts to collect and preserve history and heritage in the Heritage Room;
- Liaising with the appropriate museum authorities to further preservation efforts;
- Acting as the CMPA contact point for submission of Military Police related artifacts from the field; and
- Advising the CMPA Executive Committee on support requirements for the Heritage Room.

2. The Director History and Heritage may enlist the help of other CMPA members in support of these goals.
